Book Binding

Once you have the pages of your book assembled, try one of these book binding methods:

- 1. **STAPLE + DUCT TAPE** Ideal for books that are not too thick. Staple pages together, about an 1/2 inch from the edge. Cut a piece of duct tape, an inch longer than your book. Wrap tape along both edges, covering staples. Secure ends, cut off excess tape.
- 2. HOLE PUNCH + BRADS Ideal for thicker books. Use a whole punch to make 2-3 evenly spaced holes along the edge of book. Insert paper fastener though each hole, and back back to secure. You can also thread twine or string through the holes, of you'd like instead of using paper fasteners.

Gratitude

Expressing gratitude is being thankful for what we have, the big things in life, and the simple joys. Here are some gratitude activities for kids:

- 1. **GRATITUDE JAR** Write down each person, place, thing, memory, nature item you're grateful for on little pieces of paper. Put all of these in an empty jar. Keep adding to this jar on a daily or weekly basis.
- 2. **GRATITUDE SCAVENGER HUNT** Kids search for items in their home and in nature that they're grateful for. Collect all items and discuss why these things are important to them. How would they feel if they didn't have these items? How can we help people who are in need?

DISCOVER BRANTFORD WITH RAGS

Sculptures Inspired by Glenhyrst Gardens

While discovering Brantford Rag's visited Glenhyrst Gardens and was inspired to create a sculpture!

Here are some ideas to make your own sculptures:

- Make a toothpick structure to put your toys in, using marshmallows, grapes, cheese cubes, gumdrops, blueberries, playdoh or styrofoam! Decorate with beads to make it look pretty!
- Make a cardboard structure using toilet paper tubes, egg cartons, cereal boxes, paper towel tubes, and see how high you can get it! Paint it or cover in construction paper.
- Make tin foil sculptures! Can you make your favourite animal?
- Use your food to create animals! Can you make a frog from peas, cucumber and a red pepper mouth?
- Make sculptures from just paper! Fold and bend it in interesting shapes--how can you tape or glue it together to make it pop?
