



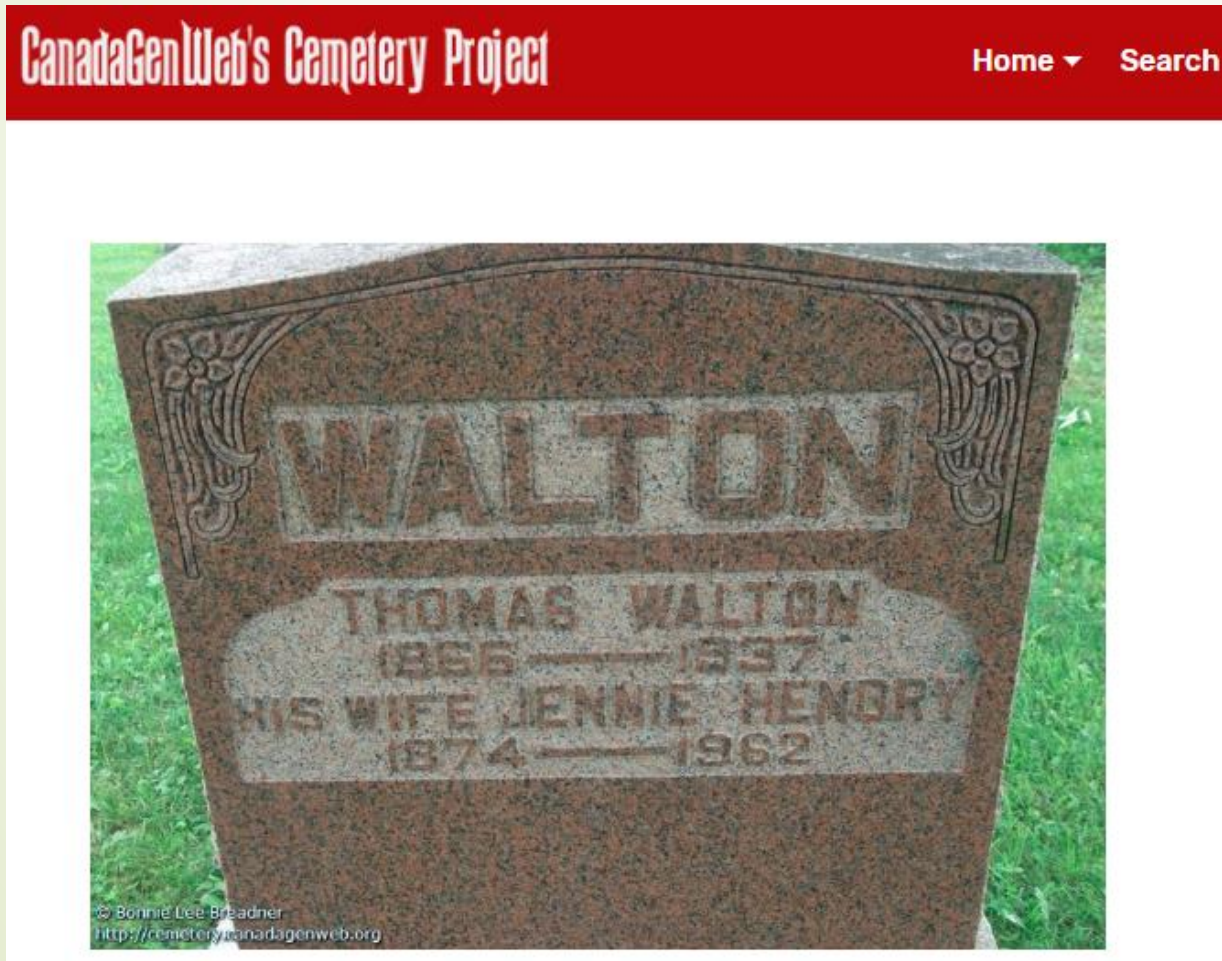

Church Records – Burial Information



Church Records

To find church records you need to:

1. Figure out the family's location at a specific time
2. Find out their religious affiliation (try the census)
3. Discover the location and the name of the appropriate church, minister, etc. through historical reference material


